## Church Lane

The West Sussex Safer Routes to School Team have been working with us to address problems in Church Lane. There was a proposal to introduce more parking, line markings and warning notices designed to encourage better traffic flow and safer drop-offs. However this is still under review and needs further consultation. In the meantime, please be reminded of our protocols:

- 1) Please try to let drivers through who are travelling away from school to avoid the risk of traffic building up and getting stuck
- 2) However, this does not mean that we have complete 'right of way' when travelling away from school and it is vital that we all take care and drive slowly, calmly and considerately. There are very few places to pass and we don't want people having to reverse dangerously.
- 3) Please do not park in the drop-off zone in the mornings. This area is to 'drop and go' to keep traffic flowing. We can not marshall this area as staff are needed in school.

A small housing development has been planned in the field on the other side from school. There will be strict rules about site traffic and when vehicles can access the lane. There will need to be an opening in the road to access this development which hopefully will create a much-needed passing place where many of you have previously suggested would be a good place.
