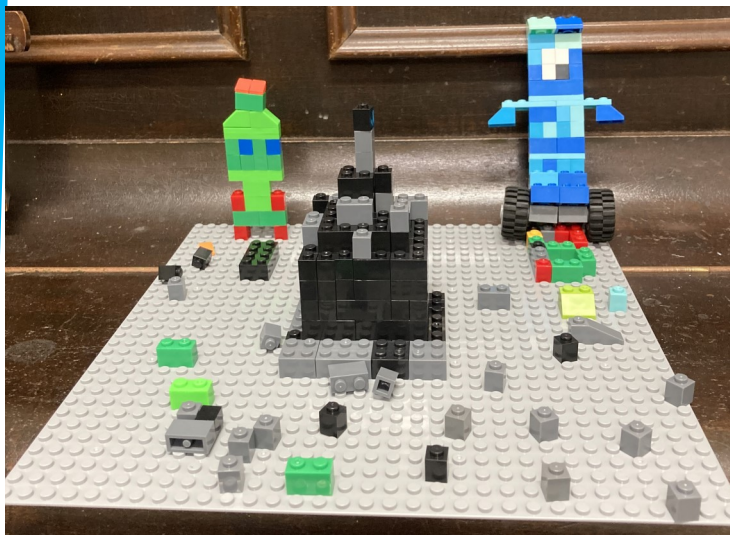


### **WREATH MAKING - Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> December, 7-9pm Outdoor Classroom**
