#### Child Fundraising

Benji from Willow class has been learning rock climbing, and this summer he climbed to the top of Stanage Edge in the Peak Distract to raise money for the Rainforest.

So far he's raised over £1000 for Reserva Rainforest Reserve, to help save 1,050 acres of Ecuadorian Cloud Forest. It's a brilliant charity, creating the worlds first youth-funded rainforest reserve, and working with the local community and scientists. New species are discovered in the forest all the time!
