Is Your Child Entitled to Free School Meals?

If you qualify for free hot meals, the school receives valuable funding to help support children at school. You will be eligible if you receive any of the following:

- ✓ <u>Universal Credit</u> (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- ✓ Income Support
- ✓ Income-based <u>Jobseeker's Allowance</u>
- ✓ Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- ✓ Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- ✓ The guaranteed element of state <u>Pension Credit</u>
- ✓ <u>Child Tax Credit</u> (provided you're not also entitled to <u>Working Tax Credit</u> and have an annual gross income of no more £16,190)
- ✓ Working Tax Credit run-on paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.


Church Lane
