English:



In English, we shall be sharing the book *Cosmic* by Frank Cottrell-Boyce and using this to write our own sci-fi stories. We will also write playscripts and biographies linked to our space topic. We will also look at reading and writing poetry for enjoyment and have fun playing with language.

Computing



We will be creating interactive quizzes with visual effects and scoring options. We will also look at the history of animation and using different animation techniques.

DT & Art



Linked to our work on light, we will be designing and making shadow puppets. We will then use these as a basis for our literacy work on playscripts.

French:

This term Willow class will be learning about the weather and creating weather reports. They will also learn the months of the year and birthdays.

Maths:



Following on from our work on addition and subtraction. We shall move onto multiplication and division. We will also study perimeter and area. Finally, we shall look at graphs including pictograms, line graphs and bar charts. Please remember the expectation is that all children by the end of Year 4 know their times table facts up to 12×12 . Using the Times Table Rockstars challenge on the computer is a fun way to practise this at home.

Geography and History
