Dear Parents,

We are delighted to announce fantastic SATs results for our Year 6 pupils. A huge well done to our Year 6 children who have achieved our highest scores since the new tests were introduced in 2016. Here is the headline information:

- ✓ 100% of Y6 pupils met expectations for Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS) compared to 78% nationally
- √ 93% for Reading compared to 75% nationally
- ✓ 79% for Maths compared to 76% nationally
- √ 64% for Reading, Writing and Maths combined same as national
- ✓ Our average 'scaled score' for Reading was 109, well above the national average and an increase from 103 last year
- ✓ Our average 'scaled score' for GPS was 106, up from 101 in 2017
- ✓ Our teacher assessment for writing was 71%, up from 64% last year
- ✓ Our maths 'scaled score' rose from 98 last year to 102 in 2018

The children have worked really hard and we are extremely proud of them and their efforts. Thank you to parents for being so supportive and helping children to consolidate their learning at home. All staff have contributed to the pupils' success throughout the years and now they have excelled in Year 6 with Mrs Francis, Mrs Reeves and Mrs Walker.

We hope that our Year 6 children feel fully prepared to hit the ground running at secondary school. These are excellent results and we are very pleased. This was not just cramming for tests; Year 6 pupils have enjoyed a busy and diverse year with music, sport, Bowles, Herstmonceux, curriculum weeks, cooking, French and art all contributing to a balanced curriculum. Further details about our results will be published online soon, including progress scores which are forecast to be very good.

Day of Sport: Friday 20th July

Please can all pupils wear PE kit all day this Friday. Pupils in Years 1 and 6 should have swimming kits with them too – we have our final session at The Triangle.
