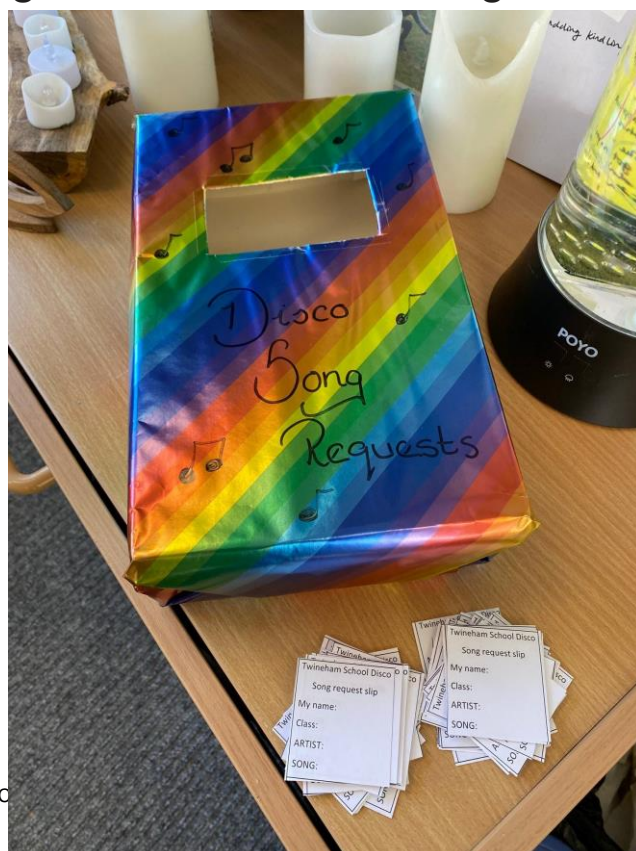

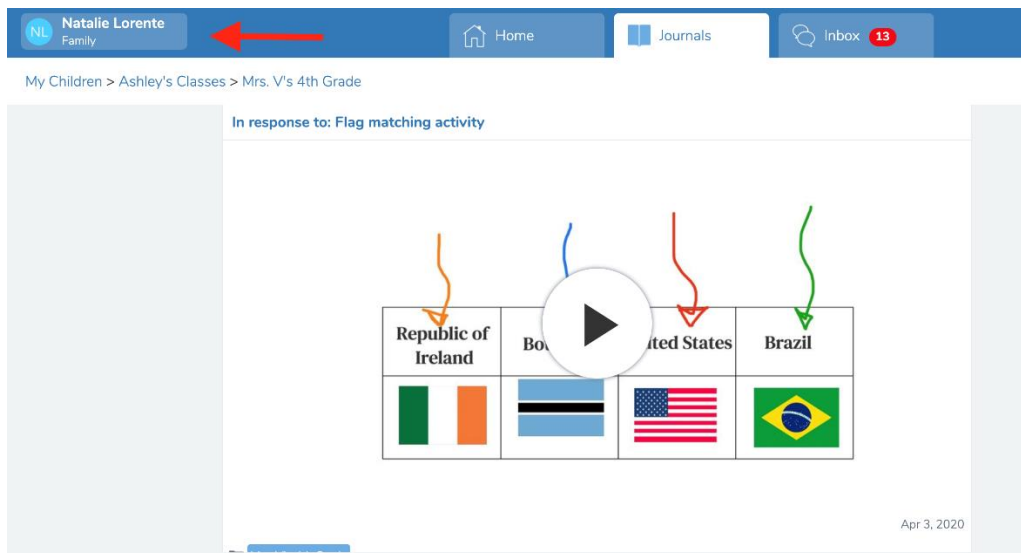
Saving Seesaw Posts

When your child moves class your child’s work on Seesaw will be archived and you will no longer be able to access it. If you want to keep any of the photos or posts please download their Seesaw file before the end of term.

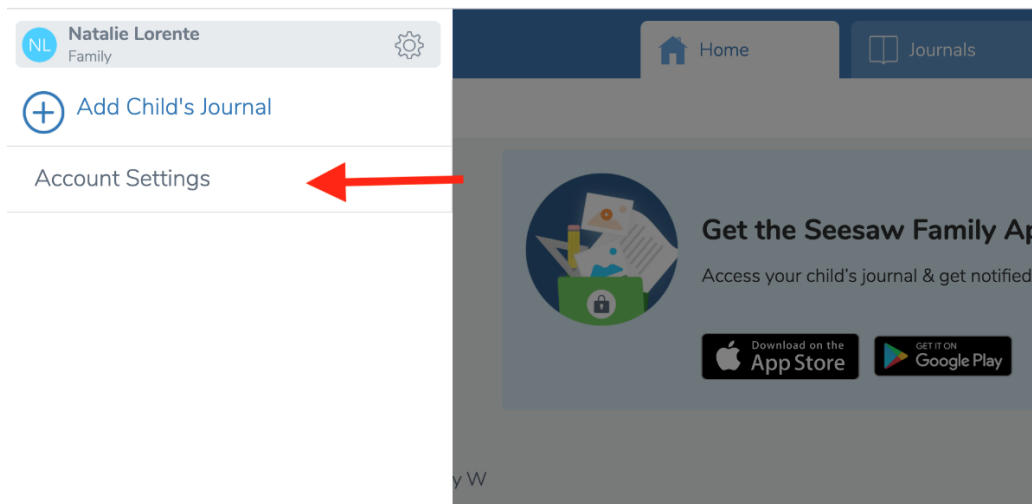
Please make sure you do not post any videos or photos including any other children on social media.

To download your Seesaw archive of work...

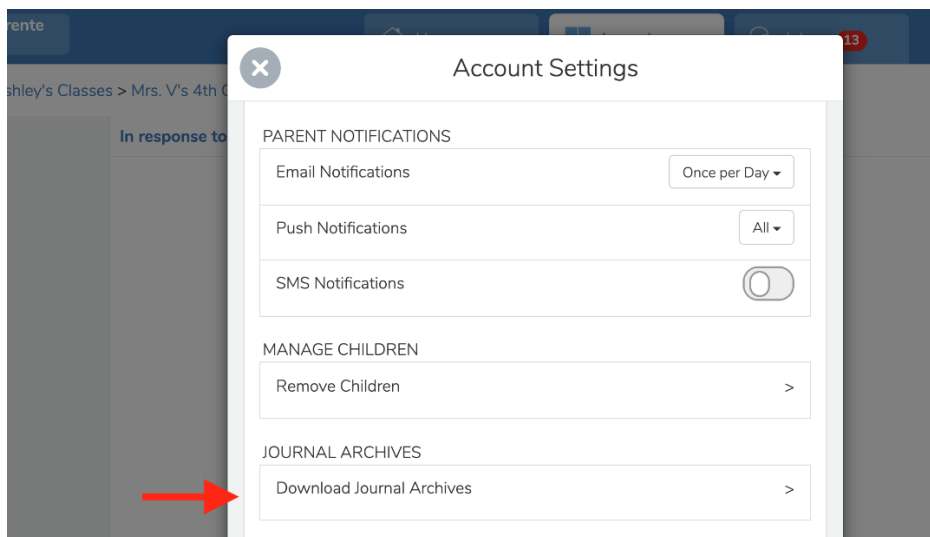
1. Sign into your Family or Student account at <https://app.seesaw.me>. (please contact your class teacher if you need a reminder of your child's Seesaw login details).
2. Click your Profile Icon on the top left.



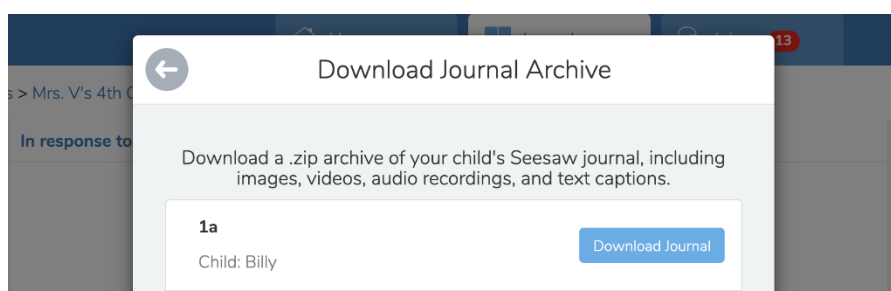
3. Click Account Settings.



4. Scroll down and click Download Journal Archives.



5. Click the Download Journal button for the journal you want to download. This might take a while depending on your Internet speed and how many posts your child has in Seesaw.



This is what you get! It is organized by month and then ordered by the date the post was added. You'll see an .html file with a thumbnail, text notes or captions, folder names and links (if the post used the Link Creative Tool). You'll also see the original image, video, or audio files.
