

Impact 2013/14

Reading therapy dogs have provided additional support giving confidence to our less confident readers. Our SENDCo investigated the impact of this provision as part of her M.A. research project and concluded that this project has helped in raising standards and confidence of our weaker readers.

Maths has been our focus this year and our progress in this area has improved, particularly in KS1. We will continue to highlight this area and are purchasing new interventions and training for staff.

Targeted children have improved their reading scores. They have used intervention material purchased with pupil premium money.

Booster sessions in Y6 helped all children but the children in receipt of pupil premium all achieved at least L4.

All our children have attended all our educational visit, swimming and residential visits and have learned from the experience and gained personal skills and confidence through their attendance. By the time they leave Twineham in Y6 nearly all our children can swim at least 25 m.

Our learning mentor has helped children with barriers for learning and her work has been acknowledged by outside agencies as being first rate and having impact.

All children apart from 1 child, made expected progress in reading, and maths, 1 child did not achieve this in writing, 3 children made more than expected progress in reading.
