Attendance: What does it mean for my child? We aim for 95%+ attendance. 9 ½ days off over This is a maximum of 9 ½ days off school over the year. That means at least 180 ½ days at school.

To get 90% attendance would mean having 19 days off over the year.

That means 171 days at school.

To get below 90% attendance would mean having more that 19 days off over the year.

That means less than 171 days at school.

## the school year is nearly <u>2 weeks of</u> missed learning.

19 days off over the school year is nearly 4 weeks of missed learning.

85% attendance would mean having 29 ½ days off school in a year. This is equivalent to nearly half a term of missed learning.

Twineham school current attendance stands at 91.9% (National is 94.9%). We open the school gates between 8:30-8:45am to allow a calm start to the day; anyone who arrives after this time is marked as late. If your child is late, they may miss vital instructions, time in intervention groups, and it could exacerbate feelings of anxiety.
