Covid-19 cases in the Christmas Holidays

We, at Twineham, will still be responsible for contact tracing in the case of a positive Covid-19 test for 6 days after the last day at school. This takes us until the 24th December 2020.

If your child develops symptoms within 48 hours of the last time they were in school and then test positive for Covid-19, please contact me using head@twineham.w-sussex.sch.uk. This will allow me to contact any close contacts in school to advise them to self-isolate.

If we receive a positive case during the holidays and need to advise your child to self-isolate, we will email you. I hope that we will not need to use this system, but wanted to let you know what to do if the need arises.

You may have seen in the news that the DfE has said we could re-allocate one of our INSET days to Friday 18th December. We have decided not to do this; it is very short notice, we have already informed you of all INSET days for the school year and you may have made plans around these dates. **The last day of term will still be Friday 18th December** and the school will finish at normal time.
